

# Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, June 4, 2024

The Regular Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on June 4, 2024, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on June 3, 2024.

## **Call to Order & Invocation**

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember Beckman to give the invocation and he asked Councilmember Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

## **Public Session:**

Mayor Atkinson asked Matthew Golden to introduce himself as the Town's new Business Liaison. He then asked if there was anyone else to speak, hearing none, he proceeded.

## **Committee Reporting**

**Recreation:** Chairman Proffitt was not present.

**Building/Grounds/IT:** Chairman Beckman is checking with several pest control companies for estimates. Mayor Atkinson updated Council about the condition of the HVAC units in our building, the bank, and the old fire department.

**HR/Special Projects/Aesthetics:** Chairperson Shaw did not have anything to report.

**Mayor's Report/Finance:** Mayor Atkinson reminded Council of the D-Day event June 6, from 11:30-12:30 at town hall, sponsored by the Semper Fi Barn and DAR Fort Prince George Chapter and the Town of Six Mile. As to the budget, he mentioned that our annual events don't seem to be bringing in the revenue that was predicted at our budget meetings and that the infrastructure issues, such as the pavilion, the septic, etc. will make the budget significantly in the red this year.

## **Consent Agenda**

The minutes for May 7 and May 14 were approved.

## **Action Items**

Councilman Beckman made a motion to adopt the first reading of Ordinance #07022024 (Rules of Decorum); Councilperson Shaw made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Councilman Beckman made a motion to accept a resolution for Repeal of Ordinance 11607 (Noxious Weeds and Vegetation) upon placement of a similar provision in the Town Zoning Ordinance. Councilperson Shaw made the second and the vote to accept this was unanimous.

Councilperson Beckman made a motion to recommend to the Planning Commission, to be appropriately placed in the Town's Zoning Ordinance, a similar alternative to current Ordinance 11607 but enforced via the Zoning Administrator. Councilperson Shaw made the second and the vote to accept this was unanimous.

Councilman Beckman made a motion to adopt an Event Policy that supersedes the previous policy. The Event Policy ensures liability coverage protection since the Town's liability specifically excludes "fireworks" and "bounce houses". No activities excluded by the Town Liability insurance carrier shall occur on town premises without Special Event Policy coverage. All such vendors, in addition, must provide the Town of Six Mile with a Certificate of Insurance that shows (1) coverage for \$1,000,000 per occurrence and (2) name the Town of Six Mile As

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
additional insured. Any event on town premises or right of way are subject to Town Council preapproval based on several factors to include the town's strategic, public purpose, and family-friendly objectives. Councilmember Shaw made the second and after some discussion, this was unanimously passed.

Councilmember Beckman made a motion to amend the Rental Reservation Form and Application for the Community Room and Downtown Park/Pavilion. Councilmember Shaw made the second and after some discussion, this was passed unanimously.


Councilmember Beckman made a motion to forward to the Planning Commission a proposal regarding livestock in the town limits for inclusion in the Town Zoning Ordinance, Councilmember Shaw made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson adjourned the meeting at 8:00 PM.
