

# Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, December 6, 2022

The regular meeting of the Six Mile Town Council was held December 6, 2022, starting at 7:00 PM at 106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C. Members in attendance were Mayor Roy Stoddard, presiding; Council: James Atkinson, Karen Bedenbaugh, Jadd Smith, and Tommy Yongue. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on December 5, 2022.

## **Call to Order & Invocation**

Mayor Stoddard asked Councilperson Bedenbaugh to give the invocation and he then led the pledge of allegiance.

## **Public Session:**

Mayor Stoddard asked Trey Whitehurst to come forward. Trey thanked Council for allowing him to serve them as County Councilman over the past years.

Kayla Holtzclaw then gave Council a report about the upcoming Christmas Events.

## **Committee Reporting**

**Safety:** Chairman Yongue gave the report from the Pickens County Sheriff's Office.

**Recreation:** Councilman Smith said the Recreation Director is still waiting for the County to fix the water leak out at Ponderosa Park. The mayor is meeting with Ken Roper next week and asked Jadd to get him a list of any issues at the park. He also mentioned that if they start the flag football, they are not going to have enough space at Ponderosa, and he asked if Council would allow them to use the green space at the new Community Park before the pavilion is built. Council granted consent.

**Administration:** Chairperson Bedenbaugh had nothing to report.

**Budget:** Chairman Atkinson had no real comments on the budget per say.

**Mayor's Report:** Mayor Stoddard reported that we are trying to find a contractor to build the pavilion at the community park. He is going to ask the County who they got to build the shelter at Hagood Mill.

## **Consent Agenda**

The minutes from November 1, 2022, were approved.

## **Action Items**

Councilmember Atkinson made a motion to open a Money Market account with United Bank, offering a 3% rate and collateralization of our funds, with the two signers to be Mayor Roy Stoddard and Clerk/Treasurer Rita Martin. Councilman Yongue made the second and the vote to open this account was unanimous.

Mayor Stoddard presented a schedule of Council meetings for the 2023 year. It was decided that the April and July meetings be changed to the second Tuesday of the month instead of the first Tuesday.

Councilman Atkinson made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Committee Appointment and Personnel Matter, Per SC State Code Section: 30-4-70(a)(1), Councilman Yongue made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Stoddard called the meeting back into regular session

Councilman Atkinson made a motion to move \$1,000 from contingency (5088) to Rec Director Salary (7003) to cover a raise the current Recreation Director's Salary from \$19,000 to \$21,000. This will be pro-rated for the remainder of the fiscal year (January through June 2023) and be taken from Contingency instead of amending the budget. Council person Bedenbaugh made the second and the vote passed unanimously.

# Regular Council Meeting


Tuesday, December 6, 2022


Mayor Stoddard adjourned the meeting at 8:09 PM.
