

Regular Council Meeting

Wednesday, May 1, 2024

A special-called Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on May 1, 2024, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on April 30, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilman Proffitt to give the invocation; he then led the pledge of allegiance.

Public Session:

No one from the public was present.

Committee Reporting

Administration/Finance: Mayor Atkinson provided the pie charts for revenues and expenses from FY24 and FY25 and discussed comparison. He discussed passthrough revenues and the millage rate and local option sales tax offset.

He then asked Council if they could have another special-called meeting on May 14 at 1 pm. Both Council members who were present, agreed to this meeting.

Action Items

Executive Session:

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion at to go into Executive Session per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a) legal, contract and personnel matters at 1:11. Councilperson Shaw made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to regular session at 1:58 and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.


Councilmember Shaw made a motion to authorize Mayor Atkinson to execute the contract between the Town and Thomas & Hutton for the Bryson Park Entrance Design. Councilmember Proffitt made the second and the vote passed unanimously.

Mayor Atkinson adjourned the meeting at 2:00 PM.
