

# Regular Council Meeting

Thursday, February 9, 2023

The second budget meeting for FY24 was held February 9, 2023, starting at 6:00 PM at 106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C. Members in attendance were Mayor Roy Stoddard, presiding; Council: James Atkinson, Karen Bedenbaugh, Jadd Smith, and Tommy Yongue. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on February 8, 2023.

## Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Stoddard asked Councilperson Yongue to give the invocation and he then led the pledge of allegiance.

## Budget Meeting:

Mayor Stoddard asked Kayla Holtzclaw to report what she is expecting for the coming fiscal year for the Christmas Activities. She reported on the 2022 Christmas festival and turned in her resignation from the Christmas Committee. Mayor Stoddard then asked to look over Katie Rampey's proposal for the Farmers Market budget for the FY24 budget year.

Councilman Atkinson made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of the HR portion of the budget. Councilperson Bedenbaugh made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.


Mayor Stoddard called the meeting back into regular session and asked if there were any motions coming from Executive Session. Councilman Atkinson made a motion to raise the hourly rate for the current Assistant Clerk from \$11.50 to \$14.00, and a 2% raise to the current clerk salary. Councilperson Bedenbaugh made the second and the vote to approve both these line items was unanimous.

Mayor Stoddard adjourned the meeting at 7:10 PM.
