

# Regular Council Meeting

The regular Six Mile Town Council meeting was held May 3, 2022, starting at 7:00 pm at 106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C. Members in attendance were Mayor Roy Stoddard, presiding; Council: James Atkinson, Jadd Smith, and Tommy Yongue. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on April 29, 2022.

## **Call to Order & Invocation**

Mayor Stoddard gave the invocation and then led the pledge of allegiance.

## **Committee Reporting**

**Safety:** Chairperson Yongue gave the statistics report from the Pickens County Sheriff's office.

**Recreation:** Chairperson Smith reported that Diamond Day will take place May 14<sup>th</sup> and Fall Ball plans are in progress.

**Budget:** Chairperson Atkinson reported the need of a 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the proposed budget for June Council meeting and the first report on ARPA funds has been filed by CMC CPA's.

Mr. Atkinson also reported that the Bryson project is in progress and waiting on the survey of the sixty-five (65) acres to be deeded to the town.

**Mayor's report:** The Mayor reported that Red White & Brew Coffee Co is requesting to meet with Councilperson Yongue and Councilperson Atkinson about renewing the lease of the old fire station and building improvements, both Councilmen agreed to meet. Work on the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the new Community Park will start Wednesday May 4<sup>th</sup>.
