

# Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, August 2, 2022

The regular meeting of the Six Mile Town Council was held August 2, 2022, starting at 7 PM at 106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C. Members in attendance were Mayor Roy Stoddard, presiding; Council: James Atkinson, Karen Bedenbaugh, Jadd Smith, and Tommy Yongue. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on August 1, 2022.

## **Call to Order & Invocation**

Mayor Stoddard asked Councilmember Bedenbaugh to give the invocation, and he led the pledge of allegiance.

He then stated that if no one had any objections, he would like to move item 6B to an action item with a first reading. No objections were made known.

## **Committee Reporting**

**Safety:** Chairman Yongue gave the report from the Pickens County Sheriff's Office.

**Recreation:** Tim Friar said that Fall ball is gearing up with six teams, roughly 80 kids.

**Administration:** Chairperson Bedenbaugh had nothing to report.

**Budget:** Chairman Atkinson didn't have anything to report since it's so early in the fiscal year.

**Mayor's Report:** Mayor Stoddard met with W. Trey Merck this week. He would be willing to be the Town's attorney with no retainer fee. He told Council that we will need to finish up all the legal matters that are currently being handled by Adam Lambert concerning the 63+ acres that the Bryson Estate has donated to the Town of Six Mile. There has been a new state law passed, dealing with conservation easements, that is affecting this matter.

## **Consent Agenda**

The minutes from June 7, 2022, were approved.

## **Action Items**

Councilperson Atkinson made a motion to assign operating rights to Roy Stoddard and Rita Martin to the financial accounts at Carter Bank & Trust in Mooresville, NC. Councilmember Smith made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Atkinson made a motion for the first reading of Ordinance 08022022, deleting two prior Non-Reverting Ordinances (04042017 and 051419-2). Councilmember Bedenbaugh made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Atkinson made a motion to go into Executive Session: Per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a) Contractual Matter; 30-4-70- (a) (1) Committee Appointment. Councilmember Bedenbaugh made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Stoddard called the meeting back to regular session and asked if there were any motions to bring before Council. Councilmember Atkinson made a motion to accept the audit bid from our current Auditor (Love and Bailey) for one more year. Councilmember Bedenbaugh made the second and the vote was unanimous.




Mayor Stoddard adjourned the meeting at 7:45 PM.
