

# Regular Council Meeting

Monday, August 26, 2024

A Special Called Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on August 26, 2024, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Christopher King, Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on August 23, 2024.

## Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember Proffitt to give the invocation, and he asked Councilman King to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

## Executive Session

Council member Proffitt made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Councilmember King seconded the motion and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

At 1:24 PM Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back into regular session and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session. Councilmember King made a motion to proceed with the P.A.R.D. grant in the amount of \$37,700.00 for trails, park, garden area, drive and gravel as per Bryson Children's Nature Walk site master plan with 20% matching from ARPA funds, as well as proceed with a small section of protective fencing as per master plan with ARPA funds. Councilman Proffitt made the second and the vote to accept this motion was unanimous.

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to approve the curbing job at town hall for \$4,690.00 since the asphalt and striping has been completed. Councilmember Shaw made the second and this motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Councilmember Shaw seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned at 1:27 PM.
