

Special Called Budget/Council Meeting

Tuesday, February 22, 2024

A Special Called, combination Council and Budget meeting for the FY/25 was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, SC) on February 22, 2024, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman and Beau Proffitt. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on February 21, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilman Proffitt to give the invocation then asked Councilman Beckman to lead the pledge of allegiance.

Committee Reporting

Building, Grounds, IT: Chairperson Beckman said that he and Katie Rampey performed an inventory of the Connex boxes behind Town Hall. He will provide notes to Council with their ideas at the next meeting.

Recreation: Chairman Proffitt announced that there are 297 players registered for the Spring sports season with 24 teams, and a cheer camp. Stan Butler is having a coaches' meeting tonight.

Mayor's Report/Finance: Chairman Atkinson said there are no current updates for the finances pending next budget report for month end February 2024.

Action Items

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to approve taking the Recreation Director's Salary in its entirety from account 7003 unless at such time some or all this salary is contributed by Pickens County. Councilman Beckman made the second and the vote to approve the first reading of this motion was unanimous.

Executive Session:

Councilman Beckman made a motion to go into Executive Session per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a) legal and personnel matters; Councilman Proffitt made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session at 1:20 P.M. was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to regular session at 2:07 P.M. and asked if there were any motions coming from Executive Session.

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to accept the resignation of Councilman Jadd Smith from Six Mile Town Council effective April 30, 2024, as he is moving out of the town limits. Councilman Beckman made the second and the vote to accept Councilman Smith's resignation was unanimous.

Councilman Beckman made a motion to appoint Dale Garrett to the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) for a term of two years; and to appoint Robert Shaw to the BZA for a term of two years, and to appoint Rebecca Warlick to the BZA for a term of three years. Councilman Proffitt made the second and the vote to approve the appointments was unanimous.

Councilman Beckman made a motion to approve the job descriptions as updated for the Town Clerk and Assistant Town Clerk. Councilman Proffitt made the second and the vote to approve the job descriptions was unanimous.

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to increase the salary for the Town Clerk by 2% and to increase the hourly pay for the Assistant Clerk to \$15 per hour. Councilman Beckman made the second and the vote to accept these two increases in the FY25 Budget was unanimous.

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to appoint Councilman Mark Beckman to the Community Park Committee. Councilman Beckman made the second and the vote to appoint Mr. Beckman to the Community Park Committee was unanimous.


Mayor Atkinson adjourned the meeting at 2:11 PM.
