

Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, November 26, 2024

A Special Called Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on November 26, 2024, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Christopher King, Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on November 25, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember Proffitt to give the invocation, and he asked Councilman King to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Executive Session

Councilman King made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Councilmember Proffitt seconded the motion and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back into regular session and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.

Councilmember Shaw made a motion to accept the resignation of Lora Arnold from the Planning Commission, effective December 31, 2024. Councilmember King made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Shaw made a motion to appoint, based on an interview completed by Council today and with the receipt of a clean background check, John Gay to the Planning Commission effective 1/1/2025 for a three-year term. Councilmember Proffitt made the second and this motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Beckman made a motion to give the Mayor authority to proceed with purchase of a 12X20 Side Utility Shed from Parton Sheds for the amount of \$6,274.48, as well as a concrete pad with the concrete being donated by Metrocon, and the accompanying storage shelving. Councilman Proffitt made the second and the vote passed unanimously.


Councilman Proffitt made a motion to proceed with Trae's Clearing and Grading for grading of the park and garden area for approximately \$7500 of the previously approved PARD and ARPA funds directed towards the Bryson Children's Nature Walk Site. Councilmember King made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember King made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Councilmember Proffitt seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned at 2:12 PM.
