

Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, May 14, 2024

A special-called Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on May 14, 2024, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Marl Beckman, Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on May 13, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilman Beckman to give the invocation; he then asked Councilmember Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Session:

Naomi Reid from the Municipal Association of SC (MASC) spoke briefly with Council about millage, the Local Option Sales Tax offset and the "Tipping Point".

Executive Session:

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion at to go into Executive Session per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a) legal, contract and personnel matters at 1:48. Councilperson Beckman made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to regular session at 2:20 and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.

Councilmember Shaw made a motion to accept the resignation of Ryan Smith from the Recreation Board. Councilmember Proffitt made the second and the vote passed unanimously.

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion to install Jake Merck as an independent contractor relative to town repair, purchasing and maintenance projects in compliance with the Town's Purchasing Ordinance. Councilmember Shaw made the second and the vote passed unanimously.


