- 7) Consider a motion to adopt the first reading of Ordinance # 07022024 to formalize the Rules of Decorum for Six Mile Town Council meetings
- 8) Consider a motion to accept a resolution for Repeal of Ordinance 11607. Be it resolved that this Ordinance be repealed upon replacement with an alternative more appropriately located in the Town’s Zoning Ordinance and enforced via the Zoning Ordinance.

The Event Policy ensures liability coverage protection since the Town’s liability specifically excludes “fireworks” and “bounce houses. No activities excluded by the Town Liability insurance carrier shall occur on town premises without Special Events Policy coverage. All such vendors, in addition, must provide the Town of Six Mile with a Certificate of Insurance that shows (1) coverage for \$1,000,000 per occurrence and (2) name the Town of Six Mile As additional insured. Any event on town premises or right of way are subject to Town Council preapproval based on a number of factors to include the town’s strategic, public purpose, and family-friendly objectives.
