

Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, September 3, 2024

The Regular Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on September 3, 2024, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Chris King, Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on September 2, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember King to give the invocation, and he asked Councilmember Beckman to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Session:

The Mayor then asked if anyone wished to speak in public session, hearing none, he proceeded.

Guests:

The Mayor then asked Carolyn Nations, a representative of the Daughters of the Revolution, to come forward to read the proclamation declaring September 17-23 as Constitution Week. Margaret Thompson was next to tell the Council about the benefits that are available at Clemson Paw Partners.

Ellen Haynes then came to the podium to tell the Council about the pavilion site storage shed for which she is in the process of getting quotes.

Committee Reporting

Administration/Finance/Greenspace: Mayor Atkinson mentioned that the one account that deems mentioning is 5085, General Repairs and Maintenance which is overbudget primarily due to the paving, curbing and striping of the parking lot at town hall.

Public Health and Infrastructure: Chairman King discussed plans to look at upstairs at the old fire station.

Recreation: Chairman Proffitt told Council that Soccer is starting tonight, baseball and softball will start next week. On September 14 from 11-4 the Football Jamboree will take place at Ponderosa Park. Parking is a problem at the park, with no real answer to it since the park is landlocked.

IT/Safety: Chairperson Beckman gave the Sheriff's report for Pickens County.

HR/Volunteers: Chairperson Shaw said that she is planning to put into place a litter pick-up twice a year, fall and spring.

Consent Agenda

The minutes for August 6 and August 26, 2024, were approved.

Action Items

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to consider the first reading of Ordinance #10012024, to revise the Bylaws of the Recreation Board to include changing the name to the Six Mile Recreation Advisory Board, Judy Shaw seconded and the vote to approve the first reading was unanimously approved.

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion to go into Executive Session, Councilman Beckman seconded and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.


