

# Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, May 7, 2024

The Regular Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on May 7, 2024, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on May 6, 2024.

## **Call to Order & Invocation**

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember Beckman to give the invocation and he asked Councilmember Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Public Hearing:** Mayor Atkinson asked if there was anyone present who wanted to speak to the FY25 Budget, hearing none, he moved on to Public Session.

## **Public Session:**

Mayor Atkinson asked Tim Brown to come forward to give the Pavilion Conclusion Update and Summary. Niki Holliday sent her update for Senior Activities, which Mayor Atkinson relayed to Council.

## **Committee Reporting**

**Recreation:** Chairman Proffitt announced that the Soccer season has ended, and Baseball and Flag Football will be ending soon. Cheer and Football signups have already been completed for the fall and the new soccer/multi-use field has been completed.

**Building/Grounds/IT:** Chairman Beckman reported that he and Katie Rampey are going to clean out the Connex in back of town hall.

**HR/Special Projects:** Chairperson Shaw did not have anything to report.

**Mayor's Report/Finance:** With 2 months left in the budget year, Mayor Atkinson said that our infrastructure is costing, therefore the budget is going in the red this year. (Computer Network, Septic Tank, Parking Lot, Pavilion).

## **Consent Agenda**

The minutes for April 2, April 17 and May 1 meetings were approved.

## **Action Items**

Councilman Proffitt made a motion to accept the second reading of the FY25 Budget in the amount of \$390,990.00 and the Non-Reverting Recreation Budget in the amount of \$75,739.00. Councilmember Shaw made the second and the vote for the second reading of the FY25 Budget was passed unanimously.

## **Executive Session:**

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion at to go into Executive Session per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a) legal and personnel matters at 7:20; Councilman Beckman made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to regular session at 8:55 P.M. and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.

Mark Beckman made a motion to authorize Mayor Atkinson to execute an agreement with HDL Company for Business License Services; Judy Shaw made the second and the vote carried unanimously.

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Beau Proffitt made a motion to accept the addendum to Employer Resolution for participation in the State Insurance Benefits Program stating that Mayor/Council will not be considered active employees and won't be eligible for insurance benefits, effective July 1, 2024. Judy Shaw made the second and the addendum passed unanimously.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to accept the resignation of Brianna Barrett as the Town of Six Mile's Business Liaison. Judy Shaw seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to appoint Matthew Golden as the Town of Six Mile's Business Liaison. Judy Shaw seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

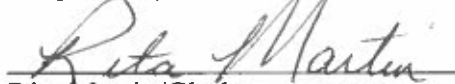

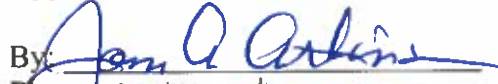
Mayor Atkinson adjourned the meeting at 8:57 PM.
