

Regular Council Meeting

Friday, October 11, 2024

A Special Called Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on September 3, 2024, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on October 10, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember Beckman to give the invocation, and he asked Councilmember Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Session:

There was no one from the public in attendance.

Action Items

Councilman Beckman made a motion to consider the second reading of Ordinance #10012024, to revise the Bylaws of the Recreation Board to include changing the name to the Six Mile Recreation Advisory Board; Councilperson Shaw made the second and the vote to approve the second reading was unanimously approved.

Councilmember Beckman made a motion to go into Executive Session, Councilperson Shaw seconded and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.


