

Regular Council Meeting

Wednesday, December 11, 2024

A Special Called Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on December 11, 2024, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on December 10, 2024.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember Proffitt to give the invocation, and he asked Councilperson Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda

Council consented for the minutes of the November 12 and 26 meetings and the proposed 2025 schedule of meetings to be approved.

Executive Session

Councilman made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Councilmember Proffitt seconded the motion and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back into regular session and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.

Councilmember Shaw made a motion to approve a raise for the Assistant Clerk for \$1.00 per hour effective immediately as authorized by the current budget. Councilmember Proffitt made the second and the vote was unanimous.


Councilmember Proffitt made a motion to authorize Mayor Atkinson to complete the waterline and other projects in process at the Bryson Children's Nature Walk using the ARPA funds, donations and PARD funds as available. Councilwoman Shaw made the second and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Proffitt made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 1:45 pm, Councilperson Shaw made the second and the motion passed unanimously.
