

Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, July 1, 2025

The Regular Town Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on July 1, 2025, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Chis King, Beau Proffitt, and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on June 30, 2025.

Call to Order & Invocation

The invocation was given by Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Zach and Alison Underwood came before Council to request housing their livestock at 130 Mt. Olivet Road, which they would like to purchase. Mayor and Council told them the Zoning Administrator, Mark Haskett, will visit the site and they would be in touch.

Ordinance 07012025 (Murals) was presented by Chris King, after some discussion, Beau Proffitt made the second and the vote to pass the first reading was unanimous.

At 7:15 PM, Mark Beckman a motion to go into Executive Session to receive legal advice relating to a pending, threatened, or potential claims or other matters covered by the attorney-client privilege, as provided by SC Code Section 30-4-70(a)(2). This item concerns legal advice regarding municipal compliance with state enabling laws relating to land use matters.

This session may also include Legal, Contractual, and/or Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Executive Session pursuant to S.C. Code Section 30-4-70(a)(2) which may include discussions related to proposed potential contractual arrangements, legal matters, and various personnel matters including Council appointments. Judy Shaw made the second. The vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to regular session at 7:40 PM and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.

Chris King made a motion to accept the proposal from McClancy Services to replace the second floor HVAC equipment upstairs at 102 South Main Street building in the amount of \$10,162.50. Judy Shaw made a second and the vote passed unanimously.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to appoint Chris King to the role of Mayor Pro Tempe effective immediately, such appointment to be reaffirmed, or not, at the first Council meeting immediately following the next general election. Mark Beckman made the second and the vote was passed unanimously.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to adjourn; Chris King made the second and the meeting was adjourned at 7:58 PM.
