

# Special Called Council Meeting

Thursday, March 25, 2025

A special-called Town Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on March 25, 2025, at 1:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Chris King, Beau Proffitt, and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on March 21, 2025.

## Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Beau Proffitt to give the Invocation, he then asked Judy Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and/or Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Executive Session pursuant to S.C. Code Section 30-4-70(a)(2) which may include discussions related to proposed potential contractual arrangements, legal matters, and various personnel matters, which may also include compensation. Chris King made the second and the vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to order at 2:11 P.M. and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session.

Judy Shaw made a motion to proceed with an independent contractor agreement with Katie Rampey as Events Coordinator/Farmer's Market Manager in the amount of \$3,000 beginning July 1, 2025. Beau Proffitt made the second and all voted in favor of this motion.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to enter into a contractual agreement with Upstate Sealant, LLC to apply pure sealant and stripe town hall parking lot in the amount of \$7,150. Chris King made the second and the vote was unanimously passed.


Beau Proffitt made a motion to authorize the mayor, with legal counsel review, to proceed with a contractual arrangement with the Community Foundation of Greater Clemson, to proceed with an Agency fund (endowment), connections for volunteer support, social support, and a succession plan all to assist with Bryson Children's Nature Walk. Judy Shaw made the second and the vote passed unanimously.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Chris King made the second and the vote to adjourn the meeting was unanimous.
